1) Can you tell me the salary for a position before I apply?

Triumph Motorcycles Limited offers a competitive remuneration package. Salary details will be discussed at interview stage.

2) How do I apply for a position with Triumph Motorcycles Limited?

Application for roles with Triumph Motorcycles Limited is by CV only; therefore it is better to resubmit your CV for each role you wish to apply for.

4) Will I be notified if my application has been unsuccessful?

Yes, we will notify you within four weeks whether your application has been successful or unsuccessful. Communication is predominantly sent out via email.

5) What about work permits and eligibility to work in the UK?

We are happy to accept applications from candidates who have secured work permits to work in the UK.

6) Do you pay relocation expenses?

Relocation expenses are payable in certain circumstances, this will be discussed at final interview stage.
