



2012 Racing Support Scheme Terms

If you intend to race a Daytona 675 or Daytona 675R, and are confident of success, you may be eligible for Triumph's Race Support Scheme, which offers preferential rates on the purchase of a bike, spare parts and accessories.

Triumph's race support scheme is administered on behalf of Triumph by T3 Racing Limited and the scheme is open to riders holding an ACU licence and competing in a recognised British club or national championship.

To apply for the scheme complete the following form and return it to:

You will then be informed by post whether or not you have been successful. Please allow 28 days for this process to be completed.

By applying for the Race Support Scheme you agree to adhere to the following conditions:

Conditions:

1. If your application is successful, T3 will then be authorised to sell certain TRIUMPH motorcycles, accessories and parts to you. Please note that your contractual relationship in relation to those motorcycles, accessories and parts will be with T3 Racing Limited who will incorporate full sale and purchase terms and conditions. However, please note the following:
 - The cost of a Daytona 675 (payable to T3 Racing Limited) will be £6250, including VAT, for a brand new 2012 spec motorcycle. This price excludes any preparation costs, which must be negotiated and agreed directly with T3 Racing Limited if required;
 - The cost of a Daytona 675R (payable to T3 Racing Limited) will be £8100, including VAT, for a brand new 201[1] spec motorcycle. This price excludes any preparation costs, which must be negotiated and agreed directly with T3 Racing Limited if required;
 - The bike will be delivered by T3 Racing Limited in standard specification, but will not be road-registered or PDI'd. While Triumph will endeavour to supply T3 Racing Limited with a UK specification model, at its own discretion Triumph may supply an equivalent performance non-UK specification machine;
 - The bike may be sold on at the end of the season, but only as a race bike. If the bike is sold before the end of the season support by Triumph or T3 Racing Limited will not be continued;
 - The motorcycles will be sold to you by T3 Racing Limited strictly exempt from



TRIUMPH's standard warranty terms and conditions and are therefore sold by T3 Racing Limited on an "as is" basis because motorcycles, parts and accessories used for racing are not covered by warranty;

- Only spares and accessories that can be justified as needed for racing will be supplied by T3 Racing Limited. The discount rate offered by TRIUMPH through T3 Racing Limited will be up to 35% off the standard retail price. A list of exemptions will be supplied to riders accepted onto the scheme.
 - Parts, accessories and race parts supplied are for the sole use of the APPLICANT and must not be resold;
 - The APPLICANT acknowledges that the Triumph Products supplied to T3 Racing Limited by TRIUMPH shall be subject to availability and that the time of supply to T3 Racing Limited is not of the essence;.
 - The APPLICANT shall inspect the Triumph Products on delivery and prior to use examine for any defects apparent on a reasonable inspection. Such defects shall be brought to T3 Racing Limited's attention by the APPLICANT in writing within 7 days.
2. The total value of motorcycles, parts, accessories and race parts sold to you by T3 Racing Limited will be limited to a level consistent with race requirements. Triumph reserves the right to withdraw the scheme if in its judgment a reasonable level is exceeded.
 3. Subject to approval of the design, TRIUMPH gives the APPLICANT permission to use the Triumph logo as part of the race bike livery for the 2012 race season. The logo must not be incorporated into the team name or team livery.
 4. TRIUMPH gives permission for the Triumph logo, as part of the race bike livery, to be used for advertising and promotional purposes directly in connection with the APPLICANT'S race activities. No other use of the Triumph logo is permitted.
 5. The APPLICANT must not produce, market or retail any product, service or merchandise bearing the Triumph logo without the express written consent of a director of TRIUMPH.
 6. The race bike livery, if containing the Triumph logo, cannot be licensed to third parties to produce, manufacture and market IP branded goods without the express written consent of a director of TRIUMPH.
 7. In relation to the Triumph Race Support Scheme and any and all related activities the APPLICANT shall not, and shall procure that any team member shall not, conduct himself in a manner or say, write, blog or do anything (including, without limitation, obscene or defamatory remarks and/or statements), which reflects adversely upon himself or the reputation of TRIUMPH, its group or its products or services or otherwise may bring TRIUMPH by association into disrepute.
 8. The APPLICANT shall provide TRIUMPH and T3 Racing Limited with regular updates on their performance, copies of all press releases and any accompanying images. The



APPLICANT gives TRIUMPH permission to use this information and images for the purposes of marketing and promotion.

9. Acceptance onto the scheme is for one race season only. Applications must be resubmitted to T3 Racing Limited each year.
10. The APPLICANT acknowledges that by its nature participating in motorcycle racing is a dangerous and hazardous activity and therefore to the extent permissible in law it waives any claims it may have for personal injury, death, damage to property or other liabilities, losses, costs and expenses relating thereto (save that for the avoidance of doubt this shall not exclude Triumph's liability for death or personal injury to the extent such liability cannot be excluded in law).
11. Triumph reserves the right to vary the terms of the Racing Support Scheme from time to time and without prior notice.
